

Storm of 2017

The July 4th weekend storm left in its wake mass destruction of public and private property. Our crews have been working around the clock to put our infrastructure back in place and to help our residents in their time of need. I have been in touch with County and State Officials in hopes of getting funds for not only Town repairs but also for the New Hartford Town residents.

For those Town of New Hartford residents, affected by the storm, I have put together the following list in order to assist our residents;

- If you suffered flood damages and have discarded items which need to be taken away our highway has dumpsters located at the Town garage which can be used for this purpose.
- Also, in some places due to the large amount of destruction of personal property we have located dumpsters in those areas to be used by those residents affected by the storm.
- If you have items which were destroyed in the storm and need to get rid of them, but have no way to get them to the highway garage call the highway department or this office and we will make arrangements to get that taken care of for you.
- As for reimbursements for items lost, i.e. furnace, hot water heaters, etc., the County has initiated a plan which will reimburse those people for some of the costs, so keep receipts and records of the costs incurred. Currently, there is no official plan in which to apply for this funding, however, a plan is anticipated within the next two days.
- As programs become available for our residents we will notify our residents via our website so please continue to monitor this site over the next several days.
