Determination of Findings
National Grid Taking for Woods Highway

The Town Board of the Town of New Hartford did conduct a Public Hearing on Wednesday, September 30, 2009, in Butler Memorial Hall, 48 Genesee Street, New Hartford to consider a taking of approximately 0.015 acres of the 6.99 acre parcel of land owned by National Grid located on or near Woods Highway bearing Tax map Number 328.000-3-8 which, if adopted, would allow necessary road and other public improvements in conjunction with the development of the New Hartford Business Park. At said public hearing the Town received no public comment and the only written comment was from National Grid. Ms. Schofield advised that no one from Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (National Grid) would be attending the Public Hearing and that they are in agreement with the proposed taking.

The Town does therefore find that this portion of the parcel would provide the additional Right of Way to allow necessary road and other public improvements in conjunction with the development of the New Hartford Business Park and would have no adverse impact on the environment and therefore will proceed with acquisition of this land. The realigned roadway would improve the safety of the traveling public by increasing sight distance and improved visibility. It will also allow drainage and utility improvements.
