

CERTIFICATE OF DESIGNATION OF A RESTRICTED HIGHWAY

To the Town Clerk of the Town of New Hartford, County of Oneida:

This is to certify that it appears to the undersigned, Deputy Commissioner of Public Works of Oneida County, necessary to designate a section of highway in the Town of New Hartford, County of Oneida, as a restricted highway, pursuant to Section 104-A of the Highway Law and Section 1625 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, said highway known as the Oxford Road, CR26A beginning at the Village of New Hartford and leading to Oneida Street.

It is necessary to restrict public travel on that portion of highway beginning at the Village of New Hartford and leading to Snowden Hill Road a distance of approximately .8 miles, as such highway is being improved by the paving of a highway and the work cannot be properly conducted and completed unless the portion above described be designated a restricted highway during the time such work is in progress.

Tentative date of paving is July 2010.
