

# Project Overview

## Brief Description

The NYS Route 840 Break In Access project seeks to develop new transportation access to the lands bound by NYS Route 840, Middle Settlement Rd., NYS Route 5 and Woods Hwy. The project builds upon nearly 20 years of studies and planning, as well as recent capital improvement projects to NYS Route 840. The potential access consists of two components: a Break-In Access of NYS Route 840 from Woods Hwy Extension and an extension of Clinton St., west of Lowes. This multi-faceted approach aims to provide an improved transportation network and stimulate economic development.

## Purpose

1. Stimulate Economic Development
2. Bolster New Hartford Tax Base
3. Improve Traffic Conditions
4. Enhance Public Infrastructure

## Components

1. Break In Access of Route 840
2. Clinton Street Extension

## Four Alternatives

1. Right-In Right-Out & Clinton Ext.
2. Jug-Handle & Clinton Ext.
3. Clinton Extension Only
4. Null/No-Action Alternative

A Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement, evaluating the impacts of the chosen alternative, will be drafted following the Town Board decision.
