Public Stormwater Concerns:

9710 Mallory Road-flow of water through back yards all the way to Mohawk Street.
2 Sylvan Way-check on work done last year.

Because of Rogers retirement, there was another discussion on the selection of a Chair, vice chair, recording secretary and spokesperson to the town board. Because there are only 6 members present, it was decided to table any selection of a Chair, vice chair, recording secretary and spokesperson until we can get input from more members. We then discussed the status of the following projects:

Jo-Anne Faulkner

Southern reservoir area- Oneida county soil and water has done some mapping and will be doing additional GPS work above the reservoirs to locate areas that can be used for detention.

Tilden Ave- Oneida county soil and water has studied the area. Have arranged to have an appraisal done this spring. Depending on the outcome, we will work on a final design for the area and hope to do construction this summer, probably with Town forces.

Cole Property on Cascade Drive-possible replacement of driveway pipe with a box culvert and also replace the culvert on Cascade Drive at an est. cost of \$40,000

Long Property at 4034 Oneida Street-Drainage improvements in back yard and near townhouses on Danberry Road at an est. cost of \$15,000.

Woodberry at Oxford Road-Discussed the scope of work and any county concerns. We hope to have this project ready for construction this summer. Plans are complete and ready for bid. Motion by Jo-Anne Faulkner and seconded by Liz DeGironimo to recommend to the Town Board to proceed with the project. Passed. *Town Board approved this project at the Feb. 11 meeting; bid date is March 11, 2009.*

Jubilee – Project is 95% designed and it is recommended that construction of this project be held till the spring because of the large amount of earthwork. Purchase offer of \$97,500 has been made for 2 lots with the required easements.
