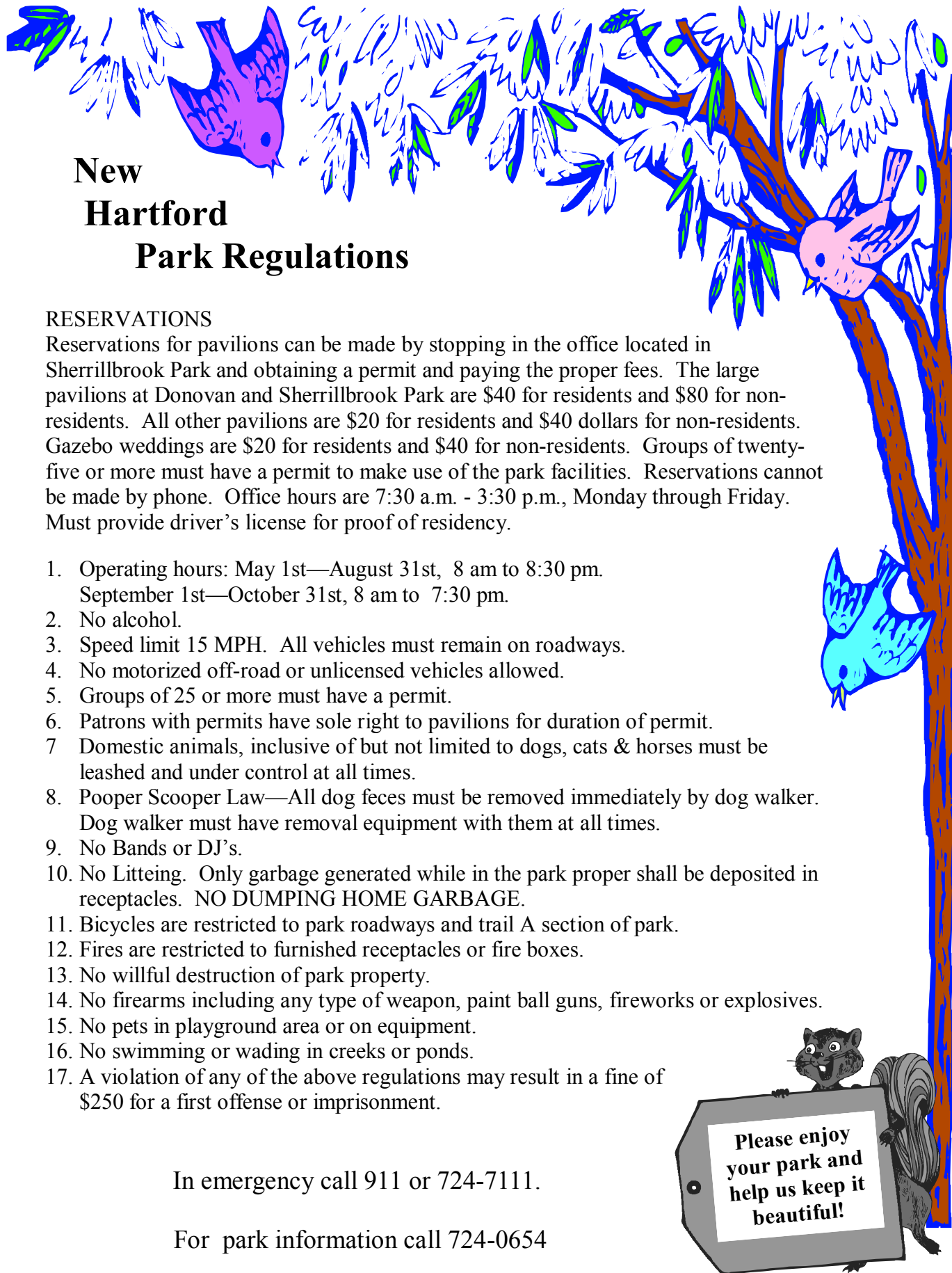

New Hartford Park Regulations

RESERVATIONS

Reservations for pavilions can be made by stopping in the office located in Sherrillbrook Park and obtaining a permit and paying the proper fees. The large pavilions at Donovan and Sherrillbrook Park are \$40 for residents and \$80 for non-residents. All other pavilions are \$20 for residents and \$40 dollars for non-residents. Gazebo weddings are \$20 for residents and \$40 for non-residents. Groups of twenty-five or more must have a permit to make use of the park facilities. Reservations cannot be made by phone. Office hours are 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Must provide driver's license for proof of residency.

1. Operating hours: May 1st—August 31st, 8 am to 8:30 pm.
September 1st—October 31st, 8 am to 7:30 pm.
2. No alcohol.
3. Speed limit 15 MPH. All vehicles must remain on roadways.
4. No motorized off-road or unlicensed vehicles allowed.
5. Groups of 25 or more must have a permit.
6. Patrons with permits have sole right to pavilions for duration of permit.
7. Domestic animals, inclusive of but not limited to dogs, cats & horses must be leashed and under control at all times.
8. Pooper Scooper Law—All dog feces must be removed immediately by dog walker. Dog walker must have removal equipment with them at all times.
9. No Bands or DJ's.
10. No Littering. Only garbage generated while in the park proper shall be deposited in receptacles. **NO DUMPING HOME GARBAGE.**
11. Bicycles are restricted to park roadways and trail A section of park.
12. Fires are restricted to furnished receptacles or fire boxes.
13. No willful destruction of park property.
14. No firearms including any type of weapon, paint ball guns, fireworks or explosives.
15. No pets in playground area or on equipment.
16. No swimming or wading in creeks or ponds.
17. A violation of any of the above regulations may result in a fine of \$250 for a first offense or imprisonment.
